I-25 South Phase II Construction

Albuquerque, NM– The New Mexico Department of Transportation announced that construction will begin on Monday, November 25, 2019 on I-25 between the NM 47/Broadway interchange north, connecting to the newly constructed Rio Bravo interchange.

This project will consist of widening I-25 and extending the Interstate to three lanes both North and Southbound between Broadway and Rio Bravo. Most of the work will be done at night for less impacts to traffic. The anticipated completion date for this project is summer of 2020.

NMDOT is working hard to continue making improvements along the Interstate system. Motorists are encouraged to proceed with caution and reduce speeds in the construction zones. For updated construction information, please visit www.nmroads.com.
