With the obvious complexities of completing a North Carolina based transaction with a Seller group from Delaware, Buyer group from Florida, and third party lease negotiation, the inclusion of the professional PLMA team allowed for everything to fall into place. With an additional complexity brought on by the approaching Hurricane Matthew coinciding with the closing schedule, the deal likely would not have happened without the onsite assistance of the PLMA team and their ability to keep the train on the rails.
