“IRP is definitely a big deal for Braun Racing,” said Stremme, driver of the TRIMSPA X32 Dodge. “Not only do we have homes and family back there, but Todd (Braun) still has his two car dealerships there, and his father's business, Braun Corp, is also in Winamac.”

Just as Braun Racing is at home in the state of Indiana, David Stremme is very much at home at the tight IRP short track; Stremme won there in 2002 in his rookie year of driving in the American Speed Association®. He has also visited victory lane at IRP in the Kendall Late Model Series in 2000.

“I am really looking forward to some good short track racing this weekend,” said Stremme. “IRP is a track I am very comfortable driving because I have had a lot of laps there.”

Stremme and Team TRIMSPA will compete in the Kroger 200 at Indianapolis Raceway Park, just down the road from the famous Indianapolis Motor Speedway, on Saturday, August 7th. The event will be televised live at 8 p.m. eastern time on TNT and on radio stations affiliated with Motor Racing Network (MRN) and XM Satellite Radio Channel 144.
