De Ridder attends trucking industry events, participates in media interviews, serves as a speaker and panelist at industry events and conducts ride-alongs for lawmakers. As a mentor, she regularly attends Girl Gala Events at high schools and community colleges. She participates in the Convoy for Hope Atlantic yearly, raising funds for cancer research and awareness. In 2019, she won first place for best-dressed driver, best-decorated truck and raising the most funds in the Convoy's 10-year history. In honor of her fundraising efforts, she proudly led the Convoy of 35 trucks, the first time ever for a female driver. De Ridder is on the cover of this month's MyPort Magazine in honor of International Women's Month.

"I am always inspiring and encouraging the next generation to join the trucking industry. I promote this in my daily travels with Clare, WIT's trucking doll. She is proudly displayed on my dash and is a great conversation starter to tell others about my awesome trucking career," said De Ridder.

"Susie De Ridder has been a visible advocate for women in the trucking industry and we are so proud to honor her with the first-ever 'Female Driver of the Year award.' Her safety standards and community involvement enhance a positive public image of the trucking industry," said Ellen Voie, president and CEO of WIT.
