2014 US Sports Car Racing Classes

Following the big merger between the ALMS and Grand Am sports car series set for 2014, the combined series class structure has now been announced.

The top level LMP1 prototypes will no longer be allowed. The top class will be a combination of the ALMS LMP2 prototypes and the Grand Am Daytona Prototypes with some equivalency limits to be set. The LMPC class for smaller spec prototypes as run in ALMS will continue. There will be two GT classes, the ALMS GT will continue and the current Grand Am GT will combine with the ALMS GT Challenge class. Look for further tweaking of the rules as the 2014 season approaches.

C7 Corvette Launched!



The biggest story from the Detroit Auto Show was the public launch of the next generation 2014 Chevrolet Corvette Stingray,

Now we will watch to see if any model kits come out in time for the GTR Summer NNL as Corvettes are the theme.

NASCAR gets \$70 million in fiscal cliff deal

Many American taxpayers weren't the only ones breathing a sigh of relief after Washington lawmakers finally came to an agreement to avoid the dreaded fiscal cliff.

NASCAR was also an unlikely beneficiary of the new legislation. The racing series, which is based in Daytona Beach, will receive a \$70 million break in the new deal. The money comes as an extension of a "seven-year cost recovery period for certain motorsports racing track facilities." The \$70 million price tag is an estimate of lost tax revenue if current tax credits, which are scheduled to expire, are extended for a year.

Nurnberg Toy Fair

Spielwarenmesse, the Nurnberg Toy Fair, will be held Jan 30 thru February 4 in Nurnberg, Germany.

Revell Germany New Kits

In advance of this major industry event Revell Germany listed some new model kits releases for 2013.

VWs: there will be three new VW kits planned for October 2013. The commercial van is a variant of the 23 Window Samba bus issued several years ago. Kit 07076.



There will be a new tool original Beetle kit, both sedan (Kit 07083) and convertible (Kit 07078) versions.



Even though longtime readers know I am a VW fanatic, I must admit the old Revell US tooling, was pretty beat up after numerous reissues. So this new mold is welcome. *(I'm still waiting for news of the current Beetle to done in plastic...)*

BMW M3 DTM: Two new BMW M3 kits from the 2012 DTM season.



Kit 07082 Martin Tomczyk and Kit 07178 2012 Bruno Spengler DTM Driver Champion. Scheduled for September release.

Red Bull 1/24 F1: The world Championship Red Bull RB8. Kit 07074 is World Driving Champion Sebastian Vettel, and Kit 07075 is for his teammate Mark Webber. Look for these in August.



Ferrari 250 GTR: I have seen conflicting news on this kit, some say a new tool while other say a modified reissue. I assume it is not the old Protar recently reissued? We can find out in July.

Fujimi: Fujimi has announced a Mercedes Benz SLS AMG GTS. Kit 312569




Scale Motorsports Decals: A new sheet for the Porsche 911 GT3 RSR Flying Lizard Team as ran at 2011 LeMans




Follow the Leader

AMT's 75 Gremlin and




MPC Bounty Hunter funny car.



First Look: MPC's Vampire Van Reissue



Description: Barnabas Vampire Van

Manufacturer: Round2 - MPC

Kit#: 763

Scale: 1/25

History: *Dark Shadows* was a daily soap opera that aired on ABC from 1966 to 1971. In an effort to boost poor ratings a vampire character, Barnabas Collins, first appeared in 1967. The vampire aspect made the show a surprise hit, and it eventually came to dominate the show.



The original actor to play Barnabas was Jonathan Frid. There have been several spin off films and shows over the years.



The latest was the *Dark Shadows* movie last year starring Johnny Depp, which I assume had some impact on Round2's decision to repop this model.

The original show became a huge hit that spawned lots of commercial tie ins. The model industry joined in, MPC issued figure kits of Barnabas Collins and a Were Wolf, and then the Vampire Van in 1969.

Kit History: MPC originally issued a kit of the 1932 Chevy a a cabriolet/sedan delivery combo about 1967. It was considered a great kit at the time. However, in those golden days of modeling, companies tended to only offer kits for a few years. So to try to captialize on the *Dark Shadows* phenomenon, MPC arranged to sell a licensed Banabas Collins Vampire Van model kit. To do so they chopped up the tolling for the 32 Chevy Sedan Delivery to add the vampire parts. There was never a van featured in the TV show so this was purely a phantom design.

This kit is mentioned in the book *Hot Rod Model Kits* by Terry Jesse (MBI, 2000). There is a description of the classic combo kit, then a quote from Bill Depuy, former MPC kit designer.

"After about two years...someboby decided that a Barnabas hot rod would be a good companion model (to their figure kits). They retooled that little Chevy sedan delivery into the Barnabas Vampire Van and really screwed it up I never really forgave them for that one"

The Kit

The kit is well packaged, as is usual for recent Round 2 kits. There is a sturdy box featuring vintage art work, and the sprues are individually wrapped. The instructions are vintage, and there are no decals. It is molded in white plastic with chromed and clear parts.



The age of this tooling is apparent by the heavy amounts of flash on many parts. Also, the fit is not very good on a lot of items.



Body: The body is molded with the side curtain windows in one piece. There is wood trim with molded grain detail (on most of it, not all), that and the side windows are to model a hearse like custom. There is an unusual front hood/fascia unit, with a hole molded into the hood for the blower to protrude through.

The rear doors are two separate pieces designed to swing open, with clear glass panels. There are a lot of chrome pieces, appropriate for a custom. This includes top and rear rails and head and tail lights that look like lanterns. These are all intended to reinforce the hearse/vampire motif. But the coffin in this kit is too long to fit inside the body! That must be why there is a separate trailer.

Trailer: This is a 14 piece assembly of a coffin on wheels, to be towed behind the van. The coffin features a hinged lid. There is a two piece figure that lies in the coffin, molded to resemble Barnabas Collins. But the figure engraving is rather poor, as is the fit of the two halves.




Engine: This is a 17 piece big block Chevy with blower. The blower parts, oil pan, belt cover and exhaust are all chromed, again typical of a custom design.

Chassis Suspension: There is a full chassis but it is somewhat simplified. There are leaf springs front and rear, and a steering linkage. The front axle is chromed. The wheels are chromed five spoke mags, they attach to the hubs by a chrome knock-off style nut.




The tires feature large, rubber hollow slicks for the rear, with the logos printed on. These are the same slicks that Round 2 has recently reissued as a separate parts package of eight tires.



Lots of chrome.

Summary: This is a dated tool, with lots of fit issues. Since it a pure phantom subject I can't comment on accuracy. I assume it will appeal to fans of the old TV show. An Internet search found it being sold at a lot of outlets not normally associated with car models, such as Hollywood memorabilia and monster themed merchandise sites. I plan to do my build up as a conversion to a surf van (still thinking of my recent Hawaii vacation now that is zero degrees as I type this!). It is well in progress so I should be able to feature this in the newsletter in a few months....




It was a nice model, something different from the multitude of 32 Ford kits. There were several other issues of the 32 Chevy by MPC.
