As discussed at the status conference held on November 20, 2015, new GM's Seventh Motion *in Limine* is DENIED without prejudice to renewal in light of the Bankruptcy Court's decision of November 9, 2015. New GM has also notified the Court that it intends to file an amended Eleventh Motion *in Limine*. (*See also* Docket No. 1746, at 3 n.2). Accordingly, its previous motion is also DENIED without prejudice to renewal. Finally, New GM's Thirteenth Motion *in Limine* is GRANTED as unopposed for purposes of the first bellwether trial (but not for purposes of future trials or with respect to other plaintiffs). (*See* Pl.'s Resp. New GM's Mot. *In Limine* No. 13 (Docket No. 1718)).

The Clerk of Court is directed to terminate 14-MD-2543, Docket Nos. 1611, 1629, and 1633; and 14-CV-8176, Docket Nos. 168 and 172.
