JESSE M. FURMAN, United States District Judge:

After conferring with Judge Tanksley following today's Status Conference, this Court and the *Melton II* Court agree to the parties' proposal to meet and confer to discuss the issues raised by the recent motions to compel in *Melton II*. Lead Counsel for Plaintiffs and counsel for New GM are directed to submit to both Courts, no later than **5 p.m. on Wednesday, November 12**, a joint letter indicating whether, or to what extent, the issues raised by the motions to compel have been resolved and, to the extent they have not been fully resolved, proposing an **expedited** briefing schedule to address both the substantive merits of any remaining disputes and whether and how the two courts should coordinate rulings on those disputes.

Counsel for GM is further ordered to serve a copy of this order on King & Spalding.
