Dear Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. NRC has decided that the defect reported may exist in our motorhomes. This recall involves Norcold refrigerators; models include 1200, 1201, 1210, and 1211.

The problem with the refrigerator is either a sensing algorithm or thermal switch to interrupt power to the refrigerator when it detects high temperatures that could lead to a fire. This recall also includes the previous recall due to the retrofitted thermal switch. The remedy is to affix a thermocouple, with a faster response time, to all refrigerators equipped with a sensing algorithm or thermal switch.
