Number of Vehicles Potentially Containing the Non-compliance 573.6 (c) (3) Four (4) vehicles are affected by this non-compliance in the United States.

Percentage of Vehicles Actually Containing the Non-compliance 573.6 (c) (4) 100% of affected vehicles contain the non-compliance.

## 573.6 (c) (5) Description of Non-compliance

A small number of 2012 model year Volkswagen CC vehicles had the factory-installed wheels and tires replaced at the port with accessory wheels and tires that were not equipped with the proper tire pressure monitoring system (TPMS) sensors. Because of this, the affected vehicles are noncompliant with FMVSS 138, "Tire Pressure Monitoring Systems."

## 573.6 (c) (6) Basis for Determination

February 2011 – 145 2012 model year Volkswagen CC vehicles were identified as having port-installed accessory wheels and tires that were not equipped with the proper tire pressure monitoring system (TPMS) sensors. A mandatory stop-sale was initiated for these vehicles on February 9, 2011. On February 19, 2011 VWGoA launched Required Vehicle Update Technical Bulletin 44J4/XO for the affected vehicles.

May 31, 2011 – VWGoA has identified four (4) vehicles in the field that were not repaired under the stop sale/RVUTB 44J4/XO actions. Because of this, the decision was made to conduct a voluntary compliance recall for these vehicles.

## 573.6 (c) (7) Non-compliance Test Result

Affected vehicles are 100% noncompliant with FMVSS 138, "Tire Pressure Monitoring Systems."

## 573.6 (c) (8) Proposed Remedial Program

As of June 1, 2011, Volkswagen has contacted all affected customers to schedule the repair appointment. At no cost to customers, Volkswagen will replace the TPMS sensors on affected vehicles with proper sensors to make the TPMS system of the vehicles compliant with FMVSS 138.
